I will respect and follow directions given by staff, parents, and student leaders involved in the production. 6. <b>Rehearsal Attendance:</b> I agree that I will be available for the rehearsal for which I am scheduled unless I am sick. If I am marked absent from school, then I may miss rehearsal. All other absences must be pre-arranged with Mrs. Blue or Mrs. Duggan <b>in writing</b> . I may <b>not</b> skip a rehearsal to participate in a LEAP program without permission at least <u>one day</u> in advance. If I have a lead, I understand I cannot participate in sports. As a chorus member in sports I must meet with the director to make arrangements in advance. 7. <b>Rehearsal Calendar:</b> I know the first rehearsal is on Wed., Dec. 18. A rehearsal calendar is provided to me and I promise to be present at all rehearsal for which I am scheduled. 8. <b>Lines:</b> I understand I must memorize all my lines <b>before</b> the first blocking rehearsal which is tentatively scheduled for February 4. 9. <b>Costumes/Props:</b> I will take care of my costumes and props. I will hang up my costume and treat all props with respect. 10. <b>Performances:</b> I will attend all performances on <b>April 3, 4, &amp; 5</b> . I will be at school <b>no later than 6:00 p.m.</b> on performance days. 11. <b>Grade Requirement for Participating: ACADEMICS COME FIRST</b> If participation in the play negatively impacts my academic standing, my parents and I will be asked to conference with the directors, teaching staff, or principal. <b>Students with 1 "F" will be on probation for two weeks. Students with 2 "Fs" will be ineligible for performances until acceptable progress is achieved.</b>
